PNAA Bylaws: Nomination and Election
(Excerpt)
Section 2: Eligibility in an elected capacity.
A. To be eligible, a nominee must have active membership status for 2 consecutive years immediately preceding election.
B. Candidates for RVP must be members in good standing of their respective regions.
C. To be eligible to serve the offices of president-elect or regional vicepresidents, a nominee must have previously served one term (or 2 years) within the last three terms (or 6 years) as either one of the following:

1. A member of the National Executive Board, or
2. A chairperson of a National Committee (standing or Adhoc), or
3. A president of a chapter

A nominee for Regional Vice -President must come from the region represented.
D. (Eligibility to serve as COPRR)
E. To be eligible for any other elected office, the nominee must have demonstrated active participation in activities of the Association at the national and / or chapter level.
F. A nominee must be a candidate for only one office at any given time and, if currently holding an elected office, may not be a candidate for another office, unless the current term expires at the time of the election.
G. Any past president of the association may run for any office after two (2) years following the end of his / her term of office.
