



PNAA Bylaws: Nomination and Election

(Excerpt)

Section 2: Eligibility in an elected capacity.

- A. To be eligible, a nominee must have active membership status for 2 consecutive years immediately preceding election.
- B. Candidates for RVP must be members in good standing of their respective regions.
- C. To be eligible to serve the offices of president-elect or regional vice-presidents, a nominee must have previously served one term (or 2 years) within the last three terms (or 6 years) as either one of the following:
 - 1. A member of the National Executive Board, or
 - 2. A chairperson of a National Committee (standing or Adhoc), or
 - 3. A president of a chapter

A nominee for Regional Vice –President must come from the region represented.

- D. (Eligibility to serve as COPRR)
- E. To be eligible for any other elected office, the nominee must have demonstrated active participation in activities of the Association at the national and / or chapter level.
- F. A nominee must be a candidate for only one office at any given time and, if currently holding an elected office, may not be a candidate for another office, unless the current term expires at the time of the election.
- G. Any past president of the association may run for any office after two (2) years following the end of his / her term of office.
